To authenticate Oracle Fusion Cloud HCM, you will need to provide the following information:

- Server URL
- User Name
- Password

- Please ensure you are an Administrator in your company's Oracle Cloud HCM instance.


Instructions

Step 1: Get your REST Server URL, username, and password from your Oracle welcome email.

You can find the Server URL, username, and password in your welcome email upon becoming a new customer of Oracle Cloud HCM.

Step 2: Enter your Oracle Cloud HCM Server URL into the linking flow
